### RoHS Compliance

**ACORDE** products delivered directly to your company or supplied through a third party are in conformance to the directive "Six Substances Regulated under RoHS".

For reference, in compliance with WEEE (EU Directive 2012/19/EU), RoHS (EU Directive 2011/65/EU) and RoHS 3 (EU Directive 2015/863 ) the maximum concentration values of the restricted substances by weight in any homogenous materials are: Cadmium/Cadmium Compounds [0.01%], Hexavalent Chromium/ Hexavalent Chromium Compounds [0.10%], Lead/Lead Compounds [0.10%], Mercury/Mercury Compounds [0.10%], Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs) [0.10%], Polybrominated Biphenylethers (PBDEs) [0.10%], Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate [0.10%], Benzyl butyl phthalate [0.10%], Dibutyl phthalate [0.10%], and Diisobutyl phthalate [0.10%].

### REACH Compliance

In the same way, **ACORDE** products are manufactured in accordance with REACH regulation (EC No 1907/2006), avoiding any **Substances of Very High Concern** for Authorization listed in last revision (25/June/2020).

**ACORDE** will continuously review the ECHA "Candidate List" for additions and updates and act accordingly in compliance with REACH regulations. In the unlikely situation that **ACORDE** product is found to contain SVHCs more than 1000 ppm by weight, **ACORDE** will comply with the notification procedures required under REACH legislation. In the meantime, **ACORDE** will also use its best efforts to update the design and eliminate the SVHC in the products.



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


